- 2003 15 acres of Dussin Vineyard's Pinot noir planted
- 2005 The winery opens on Memorial Day weekend

The Winery

Nestled into the hillside on 80 acres of prime Willamette Valley soil (both Jory and Willakenzie), this 16,000 square foot gravity-flow facility was designed under the guidance of WaterLeaf architect Stephen Lapp.
