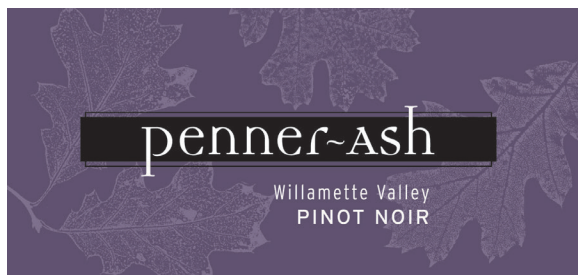


## 2012 WILLAMETTE VALLEY PINOT NOIR



Strikingly rich and layered, this pinot dances across the palate with dark berries, tea, Asian spice with a sweet cherry core and a long, persistent finish.

*Harvest Date:* September 27 – October 19, 2012

*Brix at Harvest:* 23.0 – 27.4

*Finished TA:* 5.5 g/L

*Finished pH:* 3.69

*Vineyards:* 19% Aegrina, 16% Palmer Creek, 9% Olenik, 7% Lillie's, 7% Nicholas, 6% Bella Vida, 6% Hyland, 6% Willakia, 6% Wapato Ridge. Less than 5% from Bramble Hill, Élevée, Penner-Ash Estate, Fennwood, Lazy River, Menefee, Shea and Zena Crown.

*Aging:* 10 months in 27% new French oak, 25% one year-old French oak, 19% two year-old French oak and 29% in neutral French oak

*Bottled:* September 2013

*Cases Produced:* 5,683

*Release Date:* May 2014
