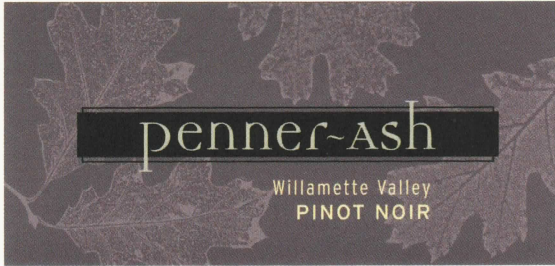


2008 WILLAMETTE VALLEY PINOT NOIR



Red cherry, violets and baking spice aromas lead into an opulent, layered and integrated palate of black cherry with hints of sandalwood. Long and expressive finish of exotic spice and vanilla.

*Harvest Date:* October 1–28, 2008

*Brix at Harvest:* 22.8–24.3

*Finished TA:* 4.8 g/L

*Finished PH:* 3.85

*Vineyards:* 18% Zena Crown, 16% Dussin, 12% Carabella, 10% Palmer Creek, 10% Olenik, 8% Sunset View Ranch, 5% Shea, 5% Bella Vida, less than 5% from Élevée, Hyland, Lia, and Ana Vineyard

*Aging:* 10 months in 30% new French oak, 30% one year-old French oak and 40% in two year-old French oak.

*Bottled:* September 2009

*Cases Produced:* 4,560
