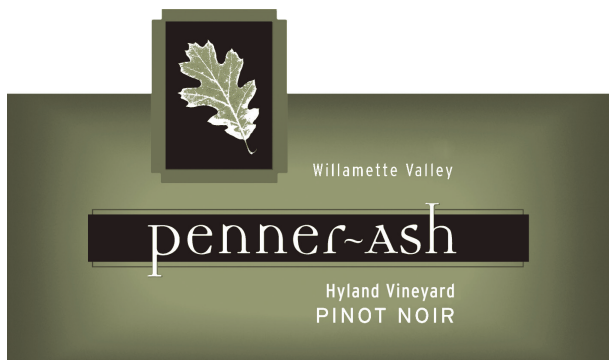


2011 HYLAND VINEYARD PINOT NOIR



Aromas of violets, red cherry and baking spice. A rich, lush entry on the palate transitions into a dense mid-palate of cherry cola, blackberry and cassis. Finish is lingering with hints of nutmeg and black pepper.
